First 6 weeks the students meet in person, covering many of the course outcomes as described on the back page.

Last 10 weeks of class students meet one day per week in the classroom (Monday), then break into small groups and will be placed at sponsoring businesses 3 days per week (Tuesday-Thursday) where students learn more in depth about the business and their industry while working with industry professionals, on Fridays the class will tour one of our many partner businesses.
